



AT THE TRAILHEAD



HISTORIC CAMPUS: A historic collection focused on agriculture, the river, and railroad, managed by the Preston Historical Society, featuring a restored 1902 Milwaukee Road elevator (on the national register of historic places), a boxcar, a caboose, a historic motor car and a schoolhouse from 1857. New in 2026 is the Depot Museum and Riverfront Center. **CHIMNEY SWIFT:** Fun Fact—Preston has the largest and most active Chimney Swift population in Minnesota! Come see them use the chimney at dusk.


